





The Parish Council is organising a

Welly Walk around Tattenhall this summer and this is how anyone can take part. It's open to residents and businesses.

- Find an old welly or two, big or small.
 Fill the toes with ballast of some sort—gravel, concrete—so that it (they) will stand up.
- Plant with flowers, vegetables or fruit—the choice is yours.
- Place your display where it can be seen.
- The Parish Council will order and supply small plugs of a variety of plants, depending on what people choose from a list which will be circulated. Compost can be ordered

too, in small bags, at minimal cost (or you can use your own).

What you need to do **NOW** is to tell us you want to take part, by the **12th March**.

A plant list will then be sent to you, so that you can choose what you want to grow. We will need your order by the **31st March**.

The Parish Council will organise dates on which your plants can be collected locally, and advice on how to plant up will be available then, if you need it.

Your welly should be planted up in May so that it's ready for display in July and August.

If you don't want to plant a welly, you could decorate one instead and a template will be available from the Parish Council. Again, please tell us you want one so that we can cut out the right number.

If you don't want to do either but have old wellies, please donate these to the Parish Council so that a big display can be set up in the centre of the village.

Walkers Nurseries and Plant Centre at Huntington is supplying everything to the Parish Council at cost price and is also offering a 20% discount voucher which can be used either in the shop or online. The Clerk will send one to those who register with her.
